


Produce Grown (pounds) - 6,279 lbs.

The 2024-2025 school year saw a **35% increase** in pounds of produce grown when compared to the 2023-2024 school year.

PRODUCE DISTRIBUTIONS



433 produce bags were distributed to **143** unique campus community members during the 2024-2025 school year. **50%** of bags were distributed directly to **students** or **family members**.



DeWitt Clinton Educational Campus students provided **1,877** pounds of fresh produce to older adults in the Bronx through our partnership with **JASA** and an additional **2,212** pounds donated to food insecure Bronx residents through our partnership with the Kingsbridge Heights Community Center.

STUDENTS ENGAGED

STUDENT ENGAGEMENT



743 campus students were directly engaged in hydroponic farm-based STEM, food justice, and nutrition education or internships.

38 different classes and programs led by **12** different educators were delivered in the farm this year for a total of **783** program hours.

Together, Teens for Food Justice and our partner schools are on a mission to end food insecurity within a generation through youth-led hydroponic farming and food justice initiatives.
