



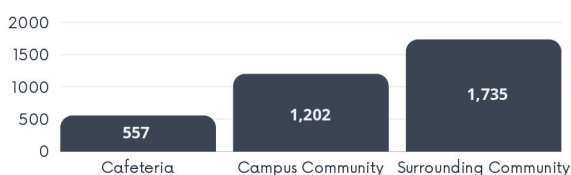

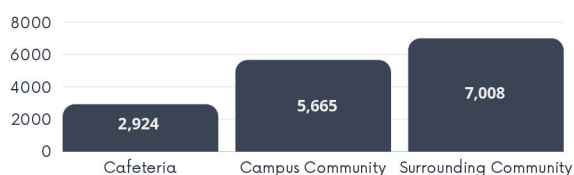
Produce Grown (pounds) - 3,494 lbs.

The 2024-2025 school year saw a **25% increase** in the number of bags distributed via campus distributions when compared to the 2023-2024 school year.

PRODUCE DISTRIBUTIONS



401 produce bags were distributed to community members on campus during the 2024-2025 school year through the **AMT student-led Hydroponics Greens Giveaway** and **QIRT Grab-n-Go**.



Far Rockaway Educational Campus students provided **1,541** pounds of fresh produce to **115** community members facing food insecurity weekly through our partnership with **Queens Defenders**. An additional **200** pounds of student-grown produce was distributed to other **partners** including RISE Rockaway, Upper Room Ministries, Child Center of New York, and The Campaign Against Hunger.

STUDENT ENGAGEMENT



240 campus students were directly engaged in hydroponic farm-based STEM, food justice, and nutrition education or internships.

16 different classes and programs, with students from all campus schools participating, engaged directly with the campus hydroponic farm during the 2024-2025 school year.

Educator engagement at FREC is up **150%** compared to last school year.
