



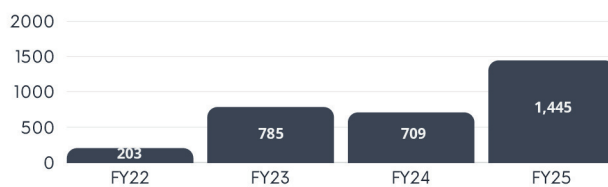

The Urban Assembly Unison School Hydroponic Farm exceeded TFFJ's projected annual yield by 145 pounds this school year.

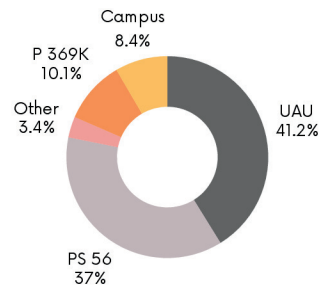
The Urban Assembly Unison Hydroponic Farm production increased **104%** during the 2024 to 2025 school year compared to the 2023 to 2024 school year.

918 produce bags were distributed to **238** unique Lewis Latimer Campus community members during the 2024-2025 school year. Over **42%** of this year's campus distribution recipients were **students or family members**.
