

## PRODUCE DISTRIBUTIONS




1,780 produce bags were distributed to 469 unique MLK, Jr. Educational Campus community members during the 2024-2025 school year. Over 40% of this year's campus distribution recipients were students.



MLK, Jr. Educational Campus students provided 2,222 pounds of fresh produce to community members, primarily older adults, through our partnership with the Lincoln Square Neighborhood Center.

## STUDENT ENGAGEMENT



467 campus students were directly engaged in hydroponic farm-based STEM, food justice, and nutrition education or internships.

Student engagement increased 70% from FY24 to FY25. Students and teachers from all five co-located schools participated in programming this year across 27 different classes and programs.
