



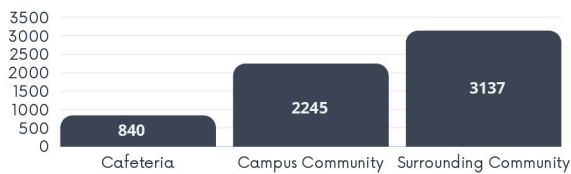

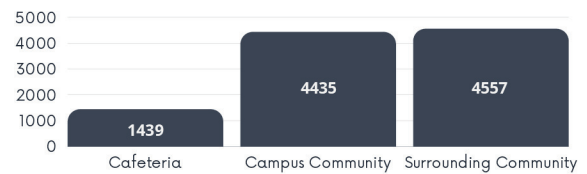

PRODUCE DISTRIBUTIONS



Over 200 community members experiencing food insecurity were served **weekly** by The Scholars' Academy Hydroponic Farm through our partnerships with **JASA** and **The Campaign Against Hunger**.



779 bags of farm fresh produce were distributed to campus families from The Scholars' Academy Hydroponic Farm through free **Campus Distributions**.
